



# Akhlaaq - Toilet Manners



Go to the toilet as soon as you need to, don't wait to finish your game, book or work!





When going to the toilet always wear slippers or shoes as the floor maybe wet or dirty.





Always try to enter with your left foot.





Use a jug or cup of water to wash yourself, if your at school and don't have one use a wet tissue to clean yourself.





Wash yourself 2 times or ask your parents to help you if you can't!





fix your clothes, wash your hands and dry them - Washing them is really important to keep away germs!





Leave the toilet with your right foot.



# Akhlaaq - Eating Manners



Always make sure food you eat is Halal





Always wash your hands before you start eating.





Always say Bismillah before you start eating





Always eat with your right hand and take small bites and chew food





Don't take with your mouth full





Only put a little on your plate, if you put too much you will waste food and eat too much. If your still hungry you can add more food later.





At the end rinse your mouth, wash your hands and dry them.



# Akhlaaq - Honesty



#### What is Honesty?

Honesty is telling the truth. Allah (swt) likes people that tell the truth. Lying is the opposite of this, its when you say something that is not true, or hide the truth. Allah (swt) has told all Muslims not to lie as it is haraam!

#### **Some Facts:**


- Our Prophet (saw) was known as the truthful one. He never lied!
- Honesty means keeping promises and never breaking them!
- A good Muslim will always tell the truth and never lies.
- Honesty is keeping Your friends secret.
- Honesty means you explain how a situation really happened. You are not being honest if you say something happened one way when it really happened another way.
- Honesty means you don't say things about people that aren't true. You are not being honest if you make up rumors about someone or if you share rumors someone else made up.

# Akhlaaq - Looking after Other People's Property

#### Taking care of other people's stuff!

Sometimes people can forget things at your house, or when you are out, or they may give you something to take care of. As a good Muslim it is your responsibility to ensure you take care of it until it is given back.

- When someone gives you something you should take care of it.
- It does not matter if it is expensive or cheap, you should take care of it the same.



Moral of story: Imam used his own candle once work was finished instead of the one he originally used as that was someone else's property.

# Akhlaaq - Cleanliness

#### Allah says that you should always keep clean

Why is it so important to be clean? If you do not keep yourself clean then you will get ill, as germs that cause sickness live in places of dirt. How do you keep yourself clean?



You should take a regular bath



Keep your clothes clean



Brush teeth morning and night



Keep your bedroom nice and clean all the time



Comb hair to keep it nice and tidy



Keep your house clean at all times



Cut your nails and keep them clean.

# Akhlaaq - Respect Teachers and Elders

A teacher who teaches any subject, in school or in Madressa is following the example of our Prophets and Imams who were also teachers, teaching us how to follow the right path. Your teachers deserve your respect because they are giving you knowledge - with which you are able to do great things.





In the same way you should respect your parents because of all that they have done for you - Listen to your parents, as they feed you, take care of you and make sure you are ok.

You should always respect those older than you as they are seen as your elders.



You shouldsay Salaam when your teacher enters the class or when you see your parents or elders.

If you can, you should help your parents or an elderly person when they need it.



## Akhlaaq - Anger

Allah says in the Qur'an: "The good people are those who swallow their anger and forgive people...."

Basically this means that we should control our anger. Why? When we get angry, we do not think properly and then we later regret and wish we could take back what we had said/done in anger.

You cannot undo something you have said or done, therefore always think before you say or do something and learn to control your anger.

Some tips on controlling your anger:



Prophet Muhammad (saw) said that anger is from Shaytan and Shaytan is made from fire and fire is put out with water, So whenever you are angry, do WUDHU!!

Everyone gets angry, sometimes for the right reasons, maybe someone said something horrible about your parents or the Prophet (saw), however in this case we should use anger wisely.
